Exclamation Mark <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skin and eye irritants • Skin sensitizers • Acute toxicity (harmful) • Narcotic effects • Respiratory tract irritants • Hazardous to ozone layer (non-mandatory) 	Flame <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flammables • Pyrophorics • Self-heating materials • Substances that emit flammable gas • Self-reactives • Organic peroxides 	Health Hazard <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carcinogens • Mutagenicity • Reproductive toxicity • Respiratory sensitizers • Target organ toxicity • Aspiration toxicity 
Flame Over Circle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oxidizers 	Exploding Bomb <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explosives • Self-reactives • Organic peroxides 	Gas Cylinder <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gases under pressure 
Corrosive <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skin corrosion/burns • Eye damage • Corrosive to metals 	Skull and Crossbones <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acute toxicity (fatal or toxic) 	Environment (Non-Mandatory) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aquatic toxicity 

NOTE: Acute toxicity has two possible pictograms: an exclamation point for "harmful" and a skull and crossbones for "fatal or toxic."
